RICE BOWL, Holy Thursday Mass:

This program is a cornerstone of Catholic Lenten practice, emphasizing solidarity with the poor and "sharing bread for life." RICE BOWL is a Lenten faith-in-action program by Catholic Relief Services (CRS) that invites U.S. Catholics to pray, fast, learn, and give to support global efforts against hunger and poverty. 25% of the funds donated stay in the local diocese for hunger and poverty alleviation efforts.
