Meals served respectively on March 6, 13, and 20 were 867, 776, & 801.

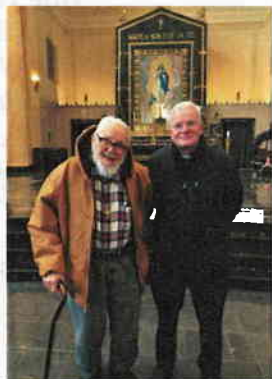
Total profit made from all three fries: \$ 16,275.18

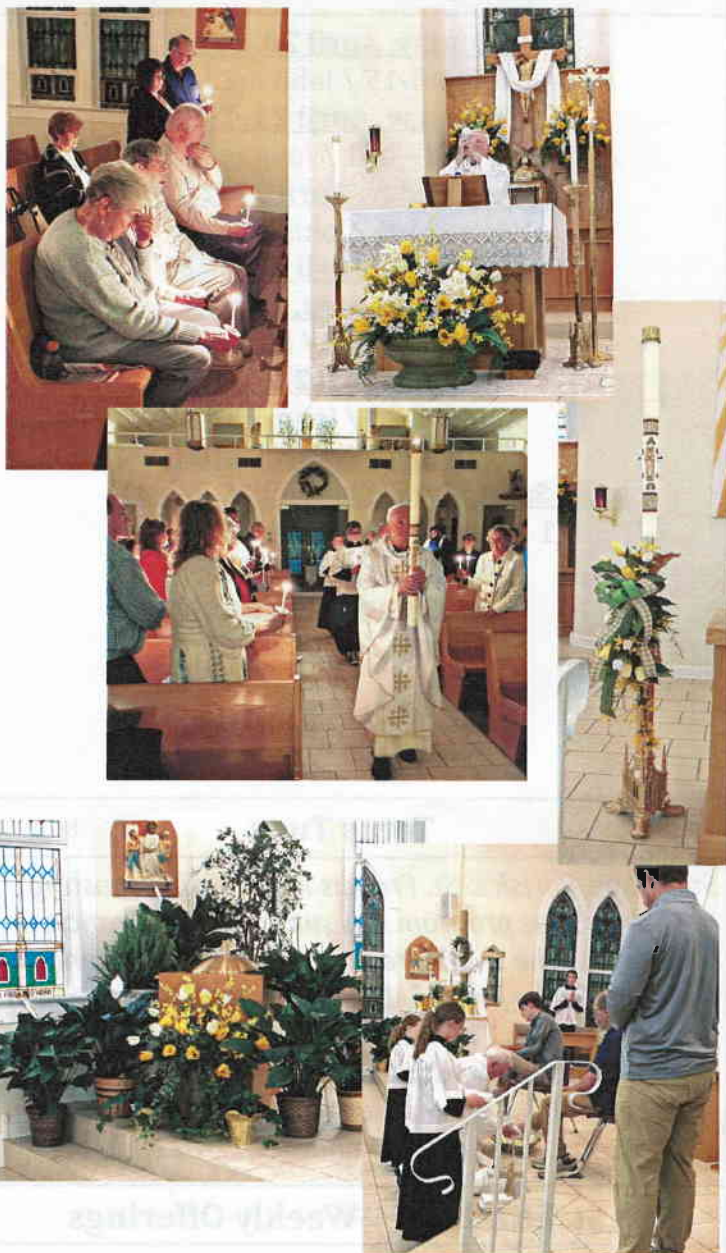
Passing of My Dad—Howard (From Fr. David)
