## Sacrament of Marriage





## The Baptism of the Lord

The **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord** commemorates the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. Originally the baptism of Christ was celebrated on Epiphany, which then commemorated the coming of The Magi, The Baptism of Christ, and the Wedding at Cana. Over time in the West, however, the celebration of The Baptism of the Lord came to be commemorated as a distinct feast from Epiphany. Long after the visit of The Magi, Pope Pius XII instituted in 1955 the 1st Sunday in Ordinary time as a liturgical commemoration of The Baptism.
