Outdoor Mass: Saturday at 4:30 on the soccer field. (Don't forget your lawn chairs!)

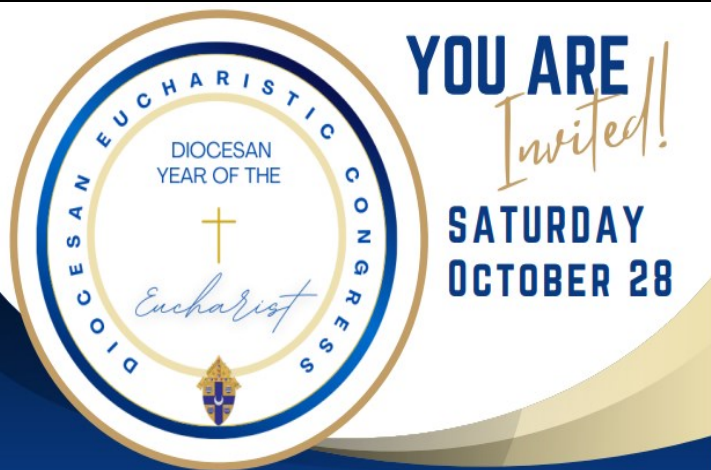

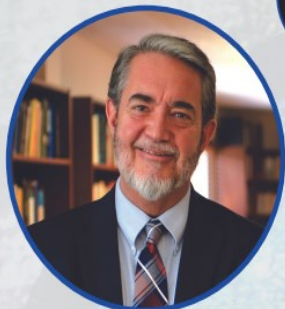

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 15, 2023, A Holy Day of Obligation

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII solemnly declared a common belief in the Catholic Church: the Immaculate Mother of God, the Ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, **was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.**

Scripture does not give an account of Mary's assumption into heaven. Nevertheless, since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus's life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary's share of His glorification. So close was she to Jesus here on earth, she must be with Him body and soul in heaven.

In the light of The Assumption of Mary, it is easy to pray her Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55) with new boldness. In her glory, she proclaims the greatness of the Lord and finds joy in God her Savior! God has, indeed, done marvelous things for her, and now she longs to share this marvel with others by bringing them closer to her Son.
