Some of you may know we recently had standing water in the church basement, quite a bit of it. We are "nipping this in the bud" before mold issues or other problems can develop. Drywall will be replaced, plus basement floor tile. The carpet by the bathroom will be addressed, plus baseboard trim and such. As we go to press, plumbers hope to open the toilet line more. (Gratefully, all the water involved was clean, and NOT sewage water.)

As for daily Mass, there will be understandable noise at times associated with the basement restoration work. We will try to minimize this disruption as best we can.

We do have insurance with a deductible. We do not know how this will impact our premiums going forward, or other enhancements we might like to have considered. Certainly the welfare of the church building is vital, a main priority. **We beseech your prayers please as this church basement project progresses. Thank you.**
